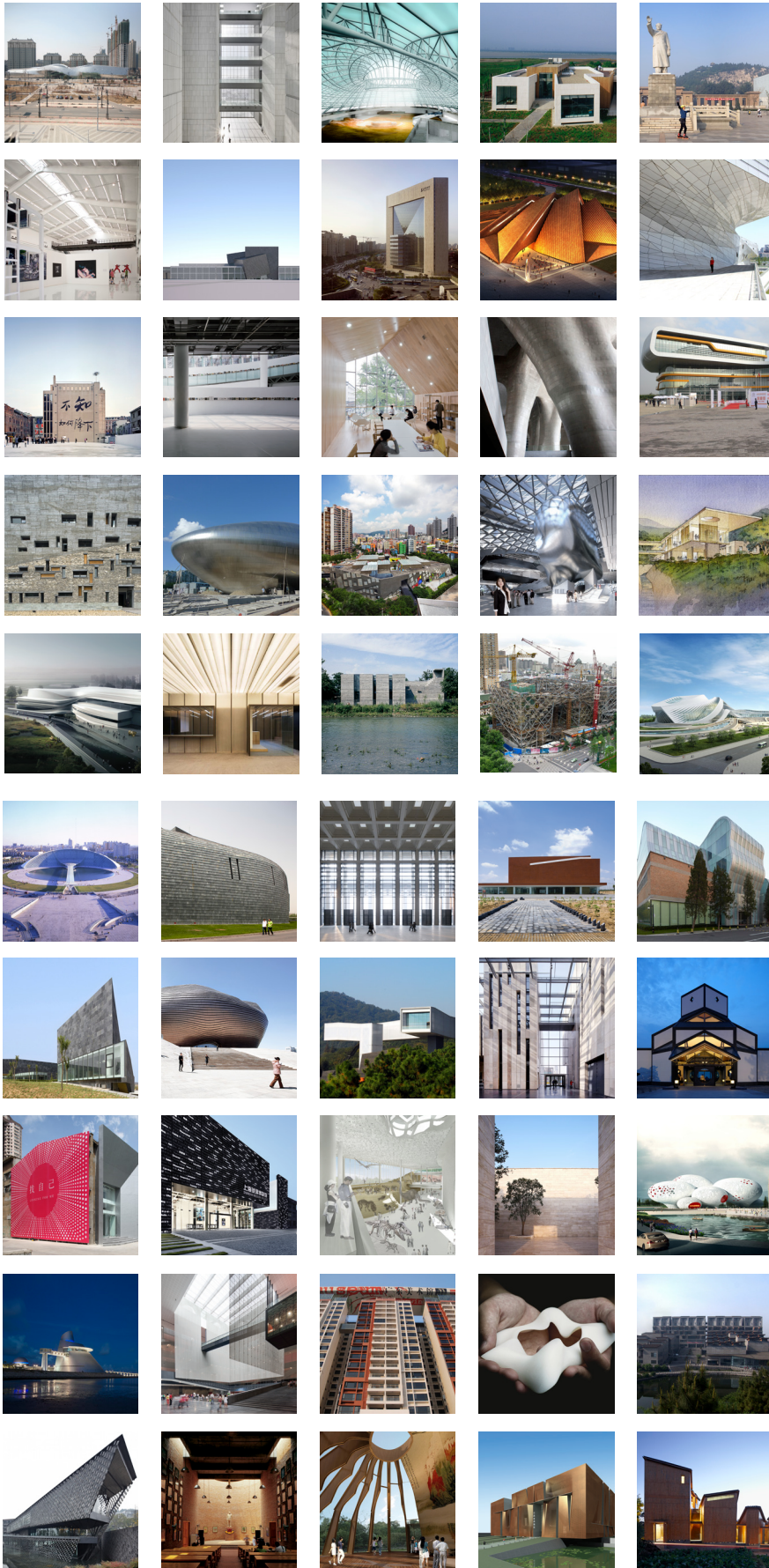


New Museums in China
