Zhang Xiaotong is Professor at the Institute of Belt and Road and Global Governance at Fudan University. He has served as Professor of Political Science and Vice Dean at Wuhan University and on the Advisory Committee for Economic and Trade Policy at the Ministry of Commerce. He has also served at the U.S. Desk of the Ministry of Commerce and as Trade Attaché at the Chinese Mission to the EU from 2004 to 2010. He was also Visiting Scholar at Johns Hopkins SAIS from 2014 to 2015. He holds a PhD In Political Science from Université Libre de Bruxelles in Belgium (ULB) and is the co-author of <u>China's Economic Diplomacy in the</u> **21st Century** and the co-editor of <u>Deepening the EU-China Partnership</u>.
