Market access is the critical factor of pharma business globally but also increasingly in China. Multinationals are facing a new paradigm in their development in China. The local companies, pharma or biotech, have also to adapt to new rules of the game.

Eric Bouteiller is Adjunct Professor at CEIBS and Co-Founder and Partner at Jumo Partners, where he advises European healthcare companies on the China market. He is author of Fundamentals of Market Access for Pharmaceuticals with Annie Chicoye. Eric has lived in China since 2001. For the French group IPSEN, he was China General Manager from 2001-2012 and Senior Vice President Asia from 2012-2017. During his career, he has held senior roles in several industry organizations. He was Vice Chair from 2011-2015 and Chair from 2016-2017 of China Association of **Enterprises with Foreign Investment's R&D-based Pharmaceutical** Association Committee (RDPAC). In 2013, he founded the French Healthcare Alliance in China where he was Chairperson from 2013-2014. He was Chairperson of the Tianjin branch of the EU Chamber of Commerce from 2008-2011 and has been French National Trade Advisor since 2007. From 1989 to 2001 he was a member of HEC Eurasia Institute of the HEC School of Management.
